DATES:

VENUE:

Waverley Netball Courts; Meet up top courts. Best approach from Birrell Street, opposite Waverley Senior School. Parking found St Mary's Avenue, Birrell St, Goldie Ave. (Or 7 minute walk from Bondi Road).

COVID SAFETY PROCEDURES:

ESCPNSA will adhere to the latest Govt Health instructions and provide the best of care to attendees. Parents & Guardians must assist ESCPSNA & follow these COVID-19 Safety Rules.

1. **SIGN-IN** commences from 8.20am with an aim to start at 9.00am. At check-in, please advise us of who will be collecting your child at 3.00pm. [Sign In](#) & [Sign Out at top courts, near amenity building](#).
2. **COVID-SAFETY QUESTION FORMS:** will be placed at SIGN-IN DESKS. Find your child(ren)'s names. The usual questions will be asked re COVID & Travel.
3. *Should your child present with COVID-19 symptoms on the morning of the clinic; they may not attend the clinic. A refund, less \$10 admin will be organised for you, if you let holidayclinics@gmail.com know the reason your child was absent.*
4. Please ensure a mini-sanitiser is packed in your child's day bag
5. The Amenity Room will be supervised to ensure that no more than 6 people are in there at any time.

WHAT TO WEAR

Wear comfortable sports clothing & strong sports shoes/socks. Bring a rain jacket and sun cap.

INJURIES/SAFETY

3. All children must alert a coach before and after visiting the bathrooms. Year 2 & Year 3 are to visit in pairs. Safety comes first.

WET WEATHER PLANNING - RAIN PREDICTED = CANCELLATION OF CLINIC for THAT DAY:

- If 'morning ` or less than 5mm predicted... we should be able to run the clinics.
- Due to Covid-19 Safety requirements, if constant Rain is forecast, we will unfortunately need to cancel the clinic. Reasons being: children being wet/cold, plus there is no shelter at the courts. (Amenity room only permits 6 people inside).
- A Refund less \$10 admin will be, issued to all booked attendees if rain causes cancellation.
